Requirements for credits/ECTS points: Credits/ECTS points will be given to students who

2) complete an original academic paper based on materials provided by the lecturer as well as on the student's own research. The paper must be no shorter than 8500 and no longer than 12,500 characters (including spaces; 12pt font; double line spacing, in Word or PDF formats only); it must include a bibliography of no less than 3 sources (website addresses accepted, but NO Wikipedia and 1 source must be a book), and at least 4 bibliographical references within the text of the paper. Any plagiarism will result in an automatic failure. The deadline for the paper is at 23:59 (11:59 pm), on Friday, July 24; submission must by email to: a.oria-bukowska@uj.edu.pl, always with a CC to: ewa.nowakowska@uj.edu.pl. Late papers will not be accepted; an incomplete course will not appear on the student's transcript.
